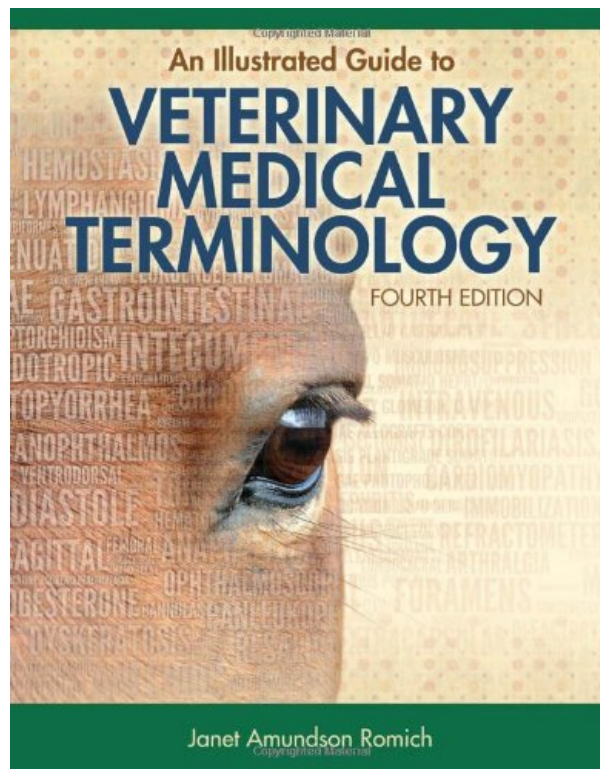
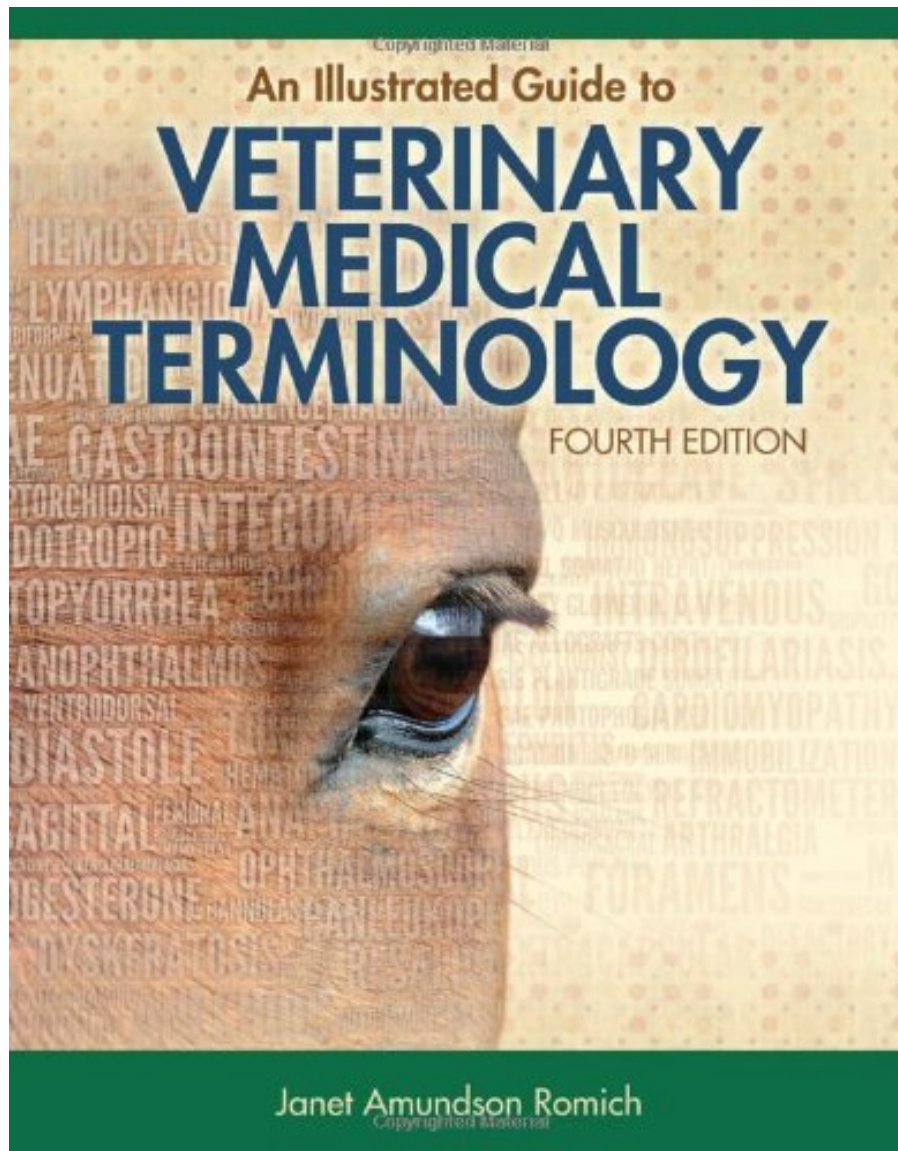

This book does not have the CD required for accessing the CourseMate online study tools. This fact is not explained clearly either in the product description or the book itself. It has great questions, case studies, and crosswords at the end of each chapter but does not have the answers anywhere in the book. You either have to get the Instructor's Manual, CourseMate or hope the instructor will provide the answers. I bought this book in advance to prepare for the class starting in September, but without the answers it is challenging to know if you have a true understanding. The book is easy to read, and presented nicely, but without the back up of CourseMate or answers to the questions it is limited. I believe you can purchase the CourseMate CD separately for \$150, that is not in my budget.
